General Membership Meeting Minutes

• Call to Order and Welcoming Remarks – Elizabeth El-Nattar

- o Meeting was called to order at 7 pm with 23 members present.
- Elizabeth welcomed all to our first PTSA meeting and introducing this year's Exec Board Members

• Approval of Meeting Minutes from 06/09/2025

o Minutes were reviewed and no questions asked; Elizabeth El-Nattar made a motion to approve, Anshu Matalia seconded, and they were approved unanimously

• Presentation of 2025-26 Budget – Sudhakara Saraswati

- Sudhakara reviewed the budget, with total revenues of \$51,330 and total expenses of \$51,175, so net revenue of \$155. Budgeting to end the year with \$43,542 in PTSA General Fund.
- The All Night Grad Party is budgeted at \$45,000 income equal to \$45,000 expenses, projected to end the year with \$16,434 cash balance.
- o Total ending cash balance projected is \$59,976
